

  - Fund a broad range of projects, programs, and organizations – large and small—in alignment with our focus areas.





# New Features: Fiscal Sponsors



# Additional New Features

- **Auto Save.** The new portal will auto-save your work every 100 characters you type and when you click out of a question.
- **Documentation.** Grant agreements and reports will be on the grant portal. You'll receive prompts and reminders to complete documentation in the system.
- **Copy and Paste.** In some instances, you may be able to copy answers from other grant applications you've previously submitted in the grant portal.




# Grant Application and Review Process

- **Step 1:** Talk to a Program Officer. Not sure who to talk with? Call the main office at 810.767.8270 or email [grants@cfgf.org](mailto:grants@cfgf.org)
- **Step 2:** Register, create login credentials, and complete the online application
- **Step 3:** Review of Application
- **Step 4:** Final Funding Decision



# Advice for Building a Strong Application

- Answer the questions directly and concisely.
- Be specific about how you will address the community need.
- Make sure your budget supports your narrative.
- Share Letters of Support from key partners, if applicable.



# Grant Award Process

- **Grant Agreement**
  - Depending on the award amount or type of project, you may be required to sign a grant agreement before payment.
- **Grant Award Letter**
  - Includes similar information in the grant agreement but does not require a signature for payment.
- **EFT Authorization Form**
  - We now offer Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) payment. If you'd like to receive grant payments via EFT, you'll need to complete the form and return it to [grants@cfgf.org](mailto:grants@cfgf.org).

- Final Reports are due **30 days following** the end of your grant period, if applicable.
- CFGF is transitioning our grant reporting to the new grant portal system and will share more about access to reporting in late **Spring 2026**.
