

**Community Foundation of Greater Flint
Scholarships to Benefit Fenton Students**

Paul and Laurencine Bader Scholarship Fund in Memory of Jodi. M. Mataya - \$1,000 awards

To be awarded to a graduating senior of the Fenton Area Public Schools. Verification of acceptance at a college or university, demonstrated financial need with preference given to students pursuing a course of study in the field of history or education. Applicants will submit an EDP plan, two recommendations and a personal essay.

James T. Botticelli Scholarship Fund - \$1,000 awards

To be awarded to a graduating senior of Fenton High School pursuing a medical field of study.

Applicant's cumulative grade point average shall be a minimum of a 3.0. Applicants will submit a brief essay describing why they chose this career path. Additional criteria include an assessment of financial need, extra-curricular activities, two recommendations and an EDP plan.

Popa Family Endowment Fund – Does not award every year. Check with school staff for more info.

To be awarded to graduates of Fenton High School who are pursuing post-secondary education and/or vocational training at accredited educational institutions. Scholarships limited to support for tuition, books and fees, and can be provided for multiple years if a grade point average of 3.0 or above (or its equivalent under any other grading system) is maintained (Gift Language). Financial need, two teacher recommendations, and EDP are all considered. This is a multi-year (4) award with new awards being made once the previous recipient has expended the full award amount.

G. Winifred Koop Scholarship Fund - \$1,000 award

To be awarded to a college bound female Fenton High School graduate with at least a 3.2 GPA. Preference will be given to a student entering into the field of Education. Additional criteria include the following:

- Student will be viewed as being of good character and will have had no major discipline issues throughout their four years at Fenton High School.
- Student will have a record of active community involvement and/or service learning.
- Student will have been an active participant in extracurricular activities.

Fenton High School Alumni Association Scholarship Fund and Horace W. Hitchcock Memorial Fund - \$2,400 awards

To be awarded to seniors of Fenton High School (FHS) who are pursuing further education in college and/or vocational school and demonstrate scholastic excellence and a demonstrated history of extra-curricular school activities. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and must have a GPA of 2.5 or better. Applicants will submit an essay of 500 words or less stating how they see themselves as an active, involved FHS Alumni member.
