To be awarded to a student with the highest cumulative GPA, and ranked second in the graduating class with a minimum two years of full-time enrollment at Holly High School; Holly area schools resident; U.S. Citizen; and verification of acceptance to college or university. Terms and conditions of the scholarship include: thank you note to Mr. Lahring by recipient; full time enrollment at a college or university; renewal limited to no more than three (3) years; periodic update of academic progress to the scholarship advisory committee by recipient; and academic success determined by a minimum 2.5 grade point average maintained by recipient. This scholarship can not be combined with the Elena Lahring Spanish Language Scholarship.

Elena Lahring Spanish Language Scholarship Fund for Holly High School

To be used to support scholarships to students of Holly High School pursuing post secondary studies and a teaching career (Gift Language). Applicant's cumulative grade point average (GPA) shall be a minimum of 3.0 and in Spanish language classes a GPA minimum of 3.25. Additional criteria include: demonstrated leadership in the classroom, Spanish Club; and Spanish National Honor Society; minimum two years of Spanish language classes; minimum two years of full-time enrollment at Holly High School; Holly area schools resident; U.S. Citizen; and verification of acceptance to college or university. Student must complete an application.

Roy and Elena Lahring Valedictorian Scholarship Fund for Holly High School

To be awarded to a student with the highest cumulative GPA, and ranked first in the graduating class with a minimum two years of full-time enrollment at Holly High School; Holly area schools resident; U.S. Citizen; and verification of acceptance to college or university. In the event of a tie, scholarship awards will be divided equally among awardees. A tie exists when two or more students share identical GPAs to the hundredth's column.
