Montrose Community Schools Scholarship

To be awarded to graduating seniors of Montrose Community Schools who are pursuing post-secondary education at a college or technical/trade school.

The applicant must have a cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.0. An essay is required and should outline the student's career path and how they plan to finance their education.

The following scholarships will be awarded:

Beulah Short Memorial Scholarship (\$500)

Must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and plan to teach.

Montrose Community Schools Scholarship (\$500)

Must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and pursue post-secondary education at a college/university or technical/vocational school.

Robert Blanford Scholarship (\$1,000)

Must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and pursue post-secondary education at a technical/vocational school.

Robert and Monna Short Scholarship

To be awarded to graduating seniors of Montrose Community Schools who are pursuing post-secondary education at a college or technical/trade school, with a preference for students pursuing a career in a technical or vocational field. Students must have attended Montrose Community Schools for 11th and 12th grades. Scholarships are based on financial need, community involvement, citizenship, academic success and work ethic. The applicant must have a cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.5. An essay is required and should outline the student's career path and how they plan to finance their education.

Awards may be renewed once. Current and past graduates submit application and a copy of program acceptance letter. Renewals based on above continued community involvement and academic success. Students should submit current program transcript and short essay describing a challenge you faced and how you worked to meet it.
