High School Students

Doris M. Logan Scholarship Fund - \$1,000 award

To be awarded to a female student residing in the city of Flint with a minimum 2.5 GPA required; financial need; demonstrated involvement in community service, an essay and plans to attend a junior college or university.

Marie Manley Scholarship - \$4,000 award(s) paid over four years

To be awarded to a female high school student enrolled and graduating from any Flint or Genesee County High School and who participated in the Flint Olympian and CANUSA Games (Gift Language) during any one of their four years in high school. Students will list school and community activities, and briefly describe their experience as a participant in the Flint Olympian and the CANSUA Games. A scholarship will be awarded over a four-year period, renewable each year, providing the recipient maintains acceptable grade standards (2.5 GPA; for schools who do not use grade point a C+ average will be required). At least three candidates will be interviewed. Each scholarship recipient will receive \$1000 per year for 4 years.

• Lacey C. Kerner Memorial Scholarship Fund - \$1,000 awards

To be awarded to any female Linden High School senior who has: 1) attended Linden High School for four (4) years; 2) graduated from Linden High School; and 3) been accepted to attend a college or university. A review of character, scholastics, involvement in co-curricular activities (student leadership, performing arts, or athletics), long term goal(s), and volunteer or community service will also be part of the selection process. The applicant must: 1) complete the required essay(s); 2) provide two letters of recommendation; and 3) attach a completed Educational Development Plan.

Scholarships for Women at the Community Foundation

Several named awards are provided each year for the benefit of female students, with at least two years of college, to support their post-secondary education:

Wanda E. Reigle Scholarship Fund - \$800 award

To be awarded to women who are academically qualified for admission or admitted to the college or university of their choice; should preferably be an adult (21 years or older); must be in need of financial assistance; must demonstrate a capacity for community involvement and service based on work and volunteer experience.

• Zonta Club of Flint I Fund - \$1,000 - \$2,000 awards

To be awarded to a career-oriented woman preparing for an executive, business or a professional position. Must have completed at least two years of college, with a cumulative GPA of 3.0, demonstrated leadership through school and community activities, resident of or student in Genesee County, financial need, and two letters of recommendation. Preference given to applicants pursuing careers in traditionally under-represented fields for women.

Nancy Yates Eby Scholarship Fund - \$1,000 awards

To be awarded to Genesee County women attending college with a cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.00. Preference will be given to students attending Baker College.
