Scholarships to Benefit University of Michigan-Flint Students**

India Scholarship Fund

To be awarded to students pursuing post-secondary education at the University of Michigan-Flint, with a minimum 3.0 GPA, and a cover letter addressing academic and career goals.

Marian F. Langworthy and J. Kelly Lugger Scholarship

To be awarded to graduates of the Clio School District attending the University of Michigan-Flint full-time with a minimum 3.2 GPA.

Woodrow W. Skaiff Scholarship Fund for the University of Michigan-Flint

Applicants must be a full-time U of M- Flint student with a minimum 3.0 grade point average and are residents of Genesee County. The awards will be granted based on financial need.

University of Michigan-Flint Scholarship Fund

Applicants must be entering freshman, transfer, and/or readmit students. Applicants must demonstrate outstanding academic potential. Incoming freshman must have a 3.0 cumulative high school grade point average (GPA) or better. Transfer and readmit students need to have a 2.5 collegiate cumulative GPA or higher. Applicants must be a resident of Flint and must be socioeconomically disadvantaged or from an underrepresented UM-Flint student population. Applicants must demonstrate financial need. Selection of award recipients will be based on a weighted combination of academic merit and financial need.
